IN THE GOOD OLD SUMMERTIME

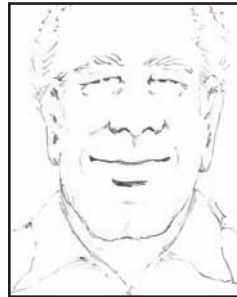

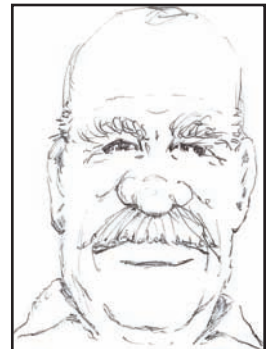
